Course Description

The presentation for the virtual board preparation for the practical portion of the AOBNMM will be presented virtually and in a similar format that is performed at the AOBNMM practical boards. There will be a 30-40 minute initial presentation discussing the general format of and required knowledge for the AOBNMM practical boards. There will be pre-recorded 10 minute interactions between a mock tester and a set of mock candidates that will demonstrate the flow of the testing in each tested modality. The modalities reviewed will be Osteopathic Cranial Manipulative Medicine, Strain-Counterstrain, Muscle Energy, High-Velocity Low Amplitude and Myofascial Release.

- Familiarize the learner with the AOBNMM practical exam format
- Familiarize the learner with proposed preparation materials
- Expose the learner to pre-recorded mock practical for OCMM, CS, ME, HVLA, and Myofascial Release
