Nominations for AAO's Academy Award

In July 2000, the Board of Trustees voted to create a new award for presentation to recipients outside the AAO family in recognition for their contributions and support to the profession. This initiative emanated from the AAO's 1999-2004 Strategic Plan. The Board of Trustees selected the first recipient at its October 2000 meeting and presented the inaugural award at the March 2001 AAO Convocation. The Trustees established the following eligibility criteria.

The recipient will:

- 1. Demonstrate commitment to osteopathic principles and to the osteopathic profession.
- 2. Exhibit outstanding efforts and/or special contributions to promote osteopathy.
- 3. Continuously show support of, and collaboration with, osteopathic organizations.
- 4. Have a vision that is complementary to the Academy's Mission.

AAO members seeking to honor a deserving AAO non-member are asked to provide their suggestions for nominees to the Awards Committee by providing a current CV and a description of 50 words or more of how the individual meets and/or exceeds the above eligibility criteria.

Upon the recommendation of the Awards Committee, the AAO Board of Trustees will select the next recipient of the AAO's Academy Award, which will be presented the following March during the AAO Convocation. The recipient will be recognized at the annual business meeting of the membership and presented with a small statue representing the Academy's logo.
